TricorBraun WinePak recognizes the growing focus on sustainability within the wine industry, especially when it comes to wine packaging. Exploring eco-friendly and lighter weight bottles is top of mind for many wineries, but what does a "lightweight" bottle really entail?

We're here to help you understand what "lightweight glass" means from a manufacturer's perspective, and what sustainable options are available to you.

Common terms used for lighter weight bottles: LIGHTWEIGHT, ECO, ULTRA-LIGHTWEIGHT

Please note: Each glass manufacturer uses their own terms of what they consider to be "lightweight" glass. At WinePak, we partner with a broad range of suppliers around the world, and each manufacture uses different language when referring to lighter weight options.

What TricorBraun WinePak considers lightweight:

ULTRA-LIGHTWEIGHT GLASS 380 - 450 grams

LIGHTWEIGHT/ ECO GLASS 405 - 505 grams

Both style bottles available in cork and screwcap neck finishes.

Important Note: When you reduce the weight of a bottle, you can get more bottles out of a ton of glass. Therefore, the amount of carbon emitted per ton of glass does not change. However, the amount of carbon emitted per bottle does decline, hence reducing your carbon footprint.
